



ORAL SURGERY CLASSES BYE-LAWS
DEPARTMENT OF ORAL SURGERY

1. The aim of the oral surgery for the third, fourth and fifth year of study is to provide information on the etiology, diagnosis and treatment of the diseases affecting oral cavity and facial skeleton, as well as acquisition of practical skills related to their surgical treatment with special emphasis on anesthesia and teeth extraction.
2. Lectures and classes on the III, IV, V year are conducted once a week on days and times indicated in the schedule of classes, starting on October 1st.
3. Classes for III, IV, V year rely on independent performance of diagnostic and treatment procedures embraced in dental surgery studies program. Additionally, students are required to master basic skills in the interview, examination and diagnosis of diseases of the oral cavity, facial skeleton and participate in surgery.
4. Attendance at lectures and classes is mandatory. Excused absences must be individually repeated at times agreed upon with the assistant teacher. The absence or failure at individual exercise prevents the accession to the ending semester colloquium.
5. The student has the opportunity to count on the twice at the assistant in the situation of absence, or failure to include the material of the exercise. Third approach is held at the tutor of the year. In situations where the student does not pass the material three times it is automatically not allowed to pass the final exam, and consequently he must apply to the Dean in accordance with the Terms and Conditions or extend the session.
6. Attendance at all exercises and getting positive reviews from the semestral tests is a necessary condition to enter practical test. Positive result on practical exam allows the student to take oral diploma exam.
7. During the classes students are obliged to wear medical coat, soft protective shoes and ID.
8. All comments and proposals concerning the classes are to be reported through the student representatives to the assistant professors or the chef department.
